Day 1: All about Scotland

Skills focus: revising present tense, descriptive language

- Discover the important inventors that came from Scotland
- Write a biography of a key historic figure

Skills focus: the simple past tense, relative pronouns

Day 3: Scottish Myths and Legends

- Read about famous Scottish legends
- Report a sighting of the Loch Ness monster
- Make a comic strip about a Scottish myth

Skills focus: the simple past tense, reporting speech

Day 4: Modern Day Scotland

- Learn about what there is to see and do in Edinburgh
- Discover the Edinburgh Fringe
- Write a festival programme

Skills focus: giving advice and suggestions, revising telling the time

Day 5: Wrapping up the Week!

- Create a tourist guide to Scotland
- Finish off work from the week
- Consolidation Games

Skills focus: revision and consolidation of vocabulary and expressions from the week
