Scenario: Our friends Emily and Jack have invited the Les Petits Bilingues students to go to the American Kids' Club in Seattle! So, it's time for them to pack their suitcases and book their flights, because they're going on holiday to America. They'll see what life is like in an American school, what the students get up to each day and learn all about Seattle!

Day 1: Welcome to Seattle!

- Introductions and icebreaker games
- Meet Emily and Jack at the Kids' Club
- Learn about popular locations in Seattle

Language focus: presenting oneself, locations

Grammar: 7-8yrs: there is/are. 9-10yrs: using the future



- Learn about hobbies and sports
- Practise asking questions
- Do a survey to find out the most popular hobbies

Language focus: hobbies and sports, question words

Grammar: 7-8yrs: 'I love/like/don't like/hate'. 9-10yrs: giving reasons (because + adjective)

Day 3: Celebrate the American traditions!

- Learn about the most popular holidays and traditions in America
- Learn about American culture
- Draw comparisons between France and America
- Craft: Make Valentine's Day Heart Glasses

Language focus: holidays and traditions, comparative adjectives, superlative **Grammar: 7-8yrs:** forming simple comparisons. **9-10yrs:** using the superlative



Day 4: A day in the life!

- Learn about the typical life of American school children
- Meet some of Emily and Jack's friends and vote for them for awards
- Craft: Make a prom king/queen crown

Language focus: school buildings, school subjects, descriptions of people **Grammar: 7-8yrs:** using 'before' and 'after'. **9-10yrs:** prepositions of place

Day 5: My ideal school

- Imagine your ideal school
- Consolidation and review
- Revision games

Language focus: future tense, consolidation and review
