Language Focus: Dancing action verbs, music vocabulary



Day 3: It's the Taj Mahal

- Identify and speak about shapes you can see everywhere
- Make a 3-D Taj Mahal

Language Focus: Numbers, shape vocabulary, place vocabulary

Day 4: Food and Festivals in India

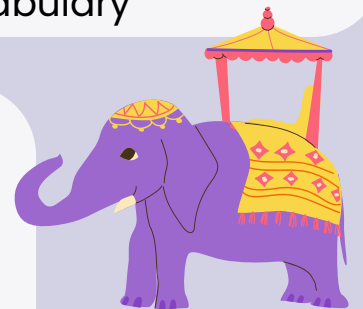
- Talk about common foods in India and express preferences

Day 1: Welcome to Incredible India!

- Discover some of the culture and symbols of India
- Learn about Indian clothing and describe clothing items
 - Make a henna hand craft
- **Language Focus:** Present simple of 'to be', present continuous, clothing vocabulary

Day 2: Lights, Camera, Bollywood!

- Learn about Bollywood and movie genres
- Discover telling time in English
 - Listen and guess the Indian musical instruments!
- **Language Focus:** Telling time, this/these, movie vocabulary, music vocabulary



Day 3: The Great Taj Mahal

- Learn about the Taj Mahal and other types of landmarks around India
- Identify and speak about different architectural elements
 - Make your own 3-D Taj Mahal
- **Language Focus:** Present simple of 'to have', landmarks and architecture vocabulary



Day 4: Let's Celebrate India

- Learn some popular foods in India
- Discover some Indian holidays and what you see at the celebrations
- Create a colourful diya lamp craft
- **Language Focus:** To see, food vocabulary, demonstrative pronouns

Day 5: India's Beloved Animals

- Identify animals that are culturally important in India
- Play games to consolidate vocabulary from throughout the week
- Create an origami elephant bookmark
- **Language Focus:** Spelling numbers, animal vocabulary, consolidation and revision

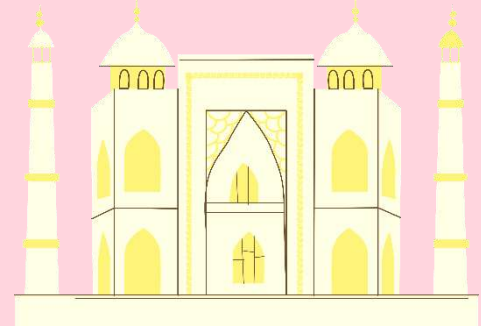
Wonder of the World: The Taj Mahal

The Great Chase Across India

Day 1: Secrets of the Mughal Empire

- Discover the city of Agra and learn about famous Mughal monuments such as the Taj Mahal
- Explore the history and architecture of grand Mughal buildings
- Uncover a mystery to solve across India

Language Focus: Idioms, quantifying articles, prepositions and verbs of movement, modal verbs for rules and possibility



Day 2: Festivals and Traditions of India

- Learn about colourful celebrations across India, such as Holi, Diwali, and the Goa Carnival
- Follow clues to track a missing person by analysing events and timelines
- Ask questions and investigate using different question forms

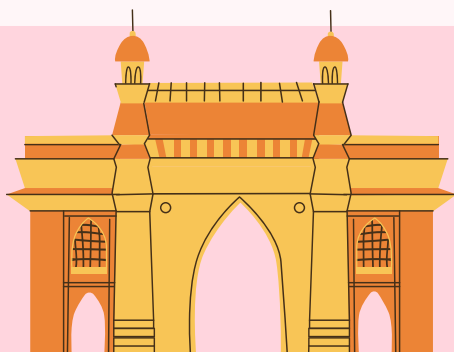
Language Focus: Gerund vs infinitive form of verb, interrogative and relative pronouns, phrasal verbs



Day 3: Mumbai - City of Dreams

- Explore the vibrant city of Mumbai, its history, and its famous landmarks, such as the Gateway of India
- Discover delicious Indian street food and describe flavours and experiences
- Make deductions about clues to continue the chase

Language Focus: Used to vs. would for past habits, modal verbs for deduction, adjectives vs adverbs of manner



Day 4: Culture and Creativity in Auroville

- Travel to Auroville and discover its unique culture and French-influenced heritage
 - Learn about poetic language and creative storytelling
 - Solve the final mystery and reveal what happened during the journey
- Language Focus:** Poetic devices, reflexive pronouns, hyperbolic expressions, verbs with 'keep' for ongoing actions
